Quotation from "The Black Cat"

- When the man kills the black cat:
- "I knew that in so doing I was committing a sin a deadly sin that would so jeopardize my immortal soul as to place it — if such a thing were possible — even beyond the reach of the infinite mercy of the Most Merciful and Most Terrible God" (164-165)

• Analyze:

- Specific words chosen by the author/narrator
- Significance of the quote's meaning to the rest of the story
- How the quote connects to/brings out themes from the story
